

MINUTES  
OF A WORKSESSION  
OF THE CLEAR LAKE CITY COUNCIL

The Clear Lake City Council met in a worksession pursuant to law and rules of said Council on Monday, October 3, 2011, at 6:00 p.m., at City Hall, with Mayor Nelson P. Crabb presiding. Council Members present: Unsworth, Furleigh, and Callanan. Absent: Cooney and Nelson.

Callanan, moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Furleigh. Roll Call: Passed Unanimously.

Police Chief Greg Peterson stated that at its previous meeting the Council was offered the donation of a boat, motor, trailer, and hoist to the City from Clear Lake Boats. He stated that the donation is valued at approximately \$17,000 and that it would cost the City approximately \$2,500 to initially outfit the boat with a radio, siren, and emergency equipment. He noted that the boat would not be used for general law enforcement patrol but would rather be used primarily in emergency situations when needed.

Council members directed general questions regarding various operational and logistical issues to Peterson who responded to the questions.

There being no further business before the Council, Furleigh moved to adjourn at 6:26 p.m., seconded by Callanan. Passed Unanimously.
